## Introduction

#### **GUID Module Functions and Permissions**



- Generate unique IDs for subjects (required for submission)
- View your existing GUIDs and Pseudo GUIDs



# GUID module capabilities

- Create a GUID
- Create multiple GUIDs (with and without error checking)
- Create a Pseudo GUID
- Convert a Pseudo GUID to a GUID
- Search if a GUID or Pseudo GUID exists in the system

**NTRR Note on GUIDs:** Since many studies submitted to NTRR may not have all the PII required to generate a GUID for each subject, investigators can generate Pseudo GUIDs, which are unique IDs not based on PII.

## Create GUIDs/PseudoGUIDs

- 1. Click "Create GUIDs" from the "GUID Tool" section in the left navigation.
- 2. Launch the GUID tool.
- 3. To create a GUID, fill out the information requested on BOTH sides.
- 4. To create a Pseudo GUID, click "Functions" in the top left corner and "generate Pseudo GUID"
- 5. Once generated, save the GUID or PseudoGUID and add in a column to your data.



#### Search if GUID or Pseudo GUID exists

- 1. Click "Create GUIDs" from the "GUID Tool" section in the left navigation.
- 2. Launch the GUID tool.
- 3. To search if a GUID or Pseudo GUID exists, click "Functions" in the top left corner and "Check if GUID/Pseudo GUID exists in the system".
- 4. Enter GUID or Pseudo GUID to check and click the "Check" button. The result will display in the bottom.
